Galatians 5:16


Spirit: AKA, Leader of the Resistance (John 16)

Retrofication: Retro (original intent) fication (to make)

The Method: Communion

The Spirit first changes our worshipper. That thing in us that defines what has ultimate value in our lives.

“You become like what you worship. When you gaze in awe, admiration, and wonder at something or someone, you begin to take on something of the character of the object of your worship.” N.T. Wright, *Simply Christian*


